May 5th – Barcelona, pelagic cruise, Ebro Delta.

May 6th – Birding the Ebro Delta.

May 7th – Birding en-route to Lleida. Inland wetlands, rivers and drylands.

May 8th – Birding the Monegros steppes.

May 9th – Birding around Lleida before Pre-Pyrenees en-route to the Pyrenees.

May 10th – Birding the high Pyrenees.

May 11th – Return to Barcelona, birding en-route.

Note: We can also arrange half- or one-day guided tours for Tarragona or Barcelona cities at the beginning or end of your stay.

Minimum group 4 persons, maximum 7 persons.

• Day 1

Balearic Shearwater – a rare regional speciality

European Storm Petrel – so difficult to see from land!

Pomarine Skua – only passing through, but we could get lucky

• Day 2

Little Bittern – a cute reedbed gem

Collared Pratincole – chatty, active, a superb flyer, a delight to watch

Slender-billed Gull – a rare gull with a delightful pink flush

• Day 3

Great Spotted Cuckoo – large, rowdy and spectacular! Little Bustard – a real (comical) showbird Red-necked Nightjar – hidden by day, revealed at dusk

• Day 4

Black-eared Wheatear – an authentic lady's bird
Black-bellied Sandgrouse – can't have one without the other
Pin-tailed Sandgrouse - ditto

• Day 5

Bonelli's Eagle – the ghost eagle Egyptian Vulture – Is it really a vulture? Bee-eater – a colourful popular favourite

• Day 6

Lammergeier – the only bone-eating bird in the world Black Woodpecker – tall, dark and handsome Citril Finch – a mountain specialist

• Day 7

We'll have to wait and see!
