



#### **ITINERARY**



DAYS 2 AND 3: Excursions to observe the Iberian Lynx on a private estate, managed by the WWF. Picnic and birding at the quiet times of day. Morning and evening stake-outs at strategic points for observation of the Iberian Lynx.

**DAY 4:** Excursions to observe the Iberian Lynx in a public area, with morning and evening stake-outs at strategic points for observation of the Iberian Lynx.

Day 5: Morning excursion for birdwatching and Lynx observation in public places. Return to Málaga or Sevilla.

# **COOL EXTREMADURA**



#### WHAT'S SPECIAL ABOUT THIS TOUR?

•See and hear large flocks of trumpeting Common Cranes •Go birding in the delightful dehesa habitat, among ancient cork oaks Watch eagles and vultures in the Monfragüe National Park

### **ITINERARY**

DAY 1: From Madrid we transfer to Torrejón el Rubio, birding en-routé, probably in steppeland and scrub habitat.

DAY 2: Monfragüe National Park. Most of the day will be spent in this magnificent park, offering opportunities for birding and bird photography.

DAY 3: Exploring the Cáceres plains in search of bustards, sandgrouse, larks and much more, followed by a short walk around the historic centre of Trujillo, and then a visit to a wintering site for Alpine Accentors.

DAY 4: The Alcollarín reservoir, irrigated fields and channels form a very interesting wetland complex well-worth discovering. There will be large flocks of cranes and plenty of aquatic birds.

DAY 5: Return to Madrid, route variable according to weather and preferences. Maybe a repeat visit to a site, a quick look at the Sierra de Gredos, or...?

# WONDERFUL **WINTER WALLCREEPER**

#### **ITINERARY**

DAYS 1 TO 3: Meeting at Barcelona, the birding starts big on the plains near Lleida. We finish in the beautiful Sierra de Guara, where we stay for three nights.

Here we visit a number of sites where both Lammergeiers and Wallcreepers are regularly encountered. We bird along the mountain roads and valleys, exploring tracks and streams for the local birdlife. The mountain scenery will be spectacular.

DAYS 4 AND 5: First off we visit the Monegros plains, including the ruins of Belchite. The next day we visit the Gallocanta area to admire the large flocks of Common Cranes and many raptors, and make a scenically delightful gorge walk.

DAYS 6 AND 7: En-route to the Ebro Delta we plan to visit a local gorge where Spanish lbex roam, an interesting wetland which is often full of ducks, and some delightful ancient olive groves. Our last full day of birding we will spend searching for birds in the Ebro Delta, among ricefields, sea bays, reedbeds, sandy beaches and lagoons.

DAY 8: We leave the Ebro Delta after some last birding and make our way back to Barcelona.

#### WHAT'S SPECIAL ABOUT THIS TOUR?

 See thousands of Common Cranes at their most important stopover site in Western Europe. •Search for Wallcreepers as they descend to accessible areas in the Pre-Pyrenees. •See Spain's mountain birds such as Lammergeiers, Black Woodpeckers, Citril Finches. Then enjoy plains and wetland birds galore too

#### **ITINERARY**

**DAY 1:** Meeting at Barcelona we drive to our first birding around Lleida before continuing on to the steppelands of Aragón, and our hotel.

DAY 2: Birding around the local steppes for larks, sandgrouse and more, as well as gorges and gallery woodland. Hotel Ebro Valley.

DAY 3: Birding en-route to the Ebro Delta. Our route will be flexible depending on the species we want to see and other factors. Night at Deltebre.

DAY 4: Birding the Ebro Delta ricefields, bays, salt pans and lagoons. Night at Deltebre.

DAY 5: There may should be time for some last birding in the Ebro Delta and en-route to our return to Barcelona.

## **ITINERARY**

DAY 1: Meet up at Barcelona or Reus airport. Transfer to hotel in Ebro Delta, birding en-route.

DAY 2: Birding the Ebro delta and en-route to Lleida.

**DAY 3:** Birding the plains around Lleida.

DAY 4: Birding around Lleida and return to Barcelona or Reus airport.

# THE SUNSHINE SOUTH

## **ITINERARY**

**DAY 1:** Departing from Sevilla we transfer to our hotel on the edge of Doñana National Park. Birding in the pre-park area, visiting marshes, wetlands, pine woods, reedbeds and

**DAY 2:** Crossing the River Guadalquivir on a ferry we investigate the bird-rich eastern shores along the Brazo del Este and the Bonanza saltpans, among others.

**DAY 3:** We head north to the sierras to look for large raptors and songbirds in a very different setting with cork oakwoods, chestnut trees and scrubland slopes.

DAY 4: We head towards Tarifa and the Straits of Gibraltar, birding en-route. We pass white-washed Andalusian towns and villages and a number of interesting birding

DAY 5: Keeping an eye on the sky and another on the straits, we'll be birding the coast, lagoons and woodland areas in search of a good variety of birds.

DAY 6: In addition to watching active migration and visiting some of the key birding areas we'll also take part on a 3-hour dolphin-watching excursion from Tarifa.

DAY 7: We hope to have time for some last migration watching in the morning before ending the tour at either Sevilla or Málaga.



# **EXTREMADURA** & COTO DOÑANA



#### WHAT'S SPECIAL ABOUT **THIS TOUR?**

•Marvel at the superb raptor spectacle in Monfrague National Park •See rare wetland birds at the Doñana National Park •Enjoy the lovely Gredos mountains, the plains, the coast-a bit of everything.

#### **ITINERARY**

**DAY 1:** Meeting at Madrid. Visit to the Sierra de Gredos en-route to the Monfragüe

**DAY 2:** Visit to the Monfragüe National Park, the dehesa, and then to a reed-fringed wetland.

**DAY 3:** Early morning to the plains near Cáceres, then breakfast and a stroll around Trujillo. Visit to Alcollarín resérvoir and Madrigalejo.

**DAY 4:** Birding along the back roads, maybe as far as Cabañas del Castillo and Guadalupe.

**DAY 5:** We leave for the Coto Doñana National Park, birding en-route at a number of stops, including the Roman bridge in Mérida.

**DAY 6:** We'll be birding the fields and wetlands of the pre-park area, the marshes, the dehesa and the local pinewoods.

DAY 7: We cross the Guadalquivir and bird along its east bank, visiting sites such as the Brazo del Este and the Bonanza saltpans.

DAY 8: Return via Sevilla airport in the morning, perhaps after a walk through the woods.

# **ITINERARY**

**DAY 1:** Meeting at Madrid we transfer to Extremadura, birding the charming Sierra de Gredos mountains en-route to our hotel on the edge of Monfragüe National Park

**DAY 2:** Visiting the National Park of Monfrague and the surrounding dehesa and wetlands.

DAY 3: Birding the extensive, flowery plains of Cáceres in search of a variety of steppeland birds, followed by a stroll around Trujillo. Then on to some wetland birds before our return.

DAY 4: We'll spend most of the day driving to the Ebro Valley. However, we'll make some time to enjoy some birding en-route.

**DAY 5:** The morning starts with a pre-breakfast outing in search of the rare and elusive Dupont's Lark. Later we visit a reed-fringed wetland, gallery woodland and Mediterranean scrubland.

DAY 6: Today we search the forests for woodpeckers, especially the Middle Spotted Woodpecker, and then stroll around the Salburua wetlands.

DAY 7: Today we're heading for the hills - the Pyrenees. En-route there will be rocky gorges, forests (more woodpeckers, including Black and White-backed!) and lush green landscapes.

DAY 8: We'll spend a whole day birding the high mountain passes between France and Spain, searching for some localised, high altitude birds.

DAY 9: Today we make a concerted effort to spot the magical Wallcreeper, before searching for warblers and buntings lower down the valley.

#### WHAT'S SPECIAL ABOUT THIS TOUR?

Get a concise look at the most spectacular birding areas in Spain
•Wonder at high mountains,

- plains, rivers, delta and a pelagic cruise •Expect over 200 species of birds!
- **DAY 10:** We make our way to Lleida via several interesting birding stops. Then we may spend some time birding around Lleida itself, where we spend one night.

DAY 11: Birding around the drylands, farmland, gallery woodland and hillsides of Lleida will allow us to catch up on some of the birds we may have missed earlier. Hotel in the Ebro Delta.

DAY 12: We spend all day birding the Ebro Delta, looking for the many wetland birds that can be found among the lagoons, ricefields, bays, reedbeds and marshes of this great wetland area.

**DAY 13:** We take a chartered vessel into the Mediterranean sea to encounter skuas. petrels, shearwaters and other seabirds. The tour ends with an afternoon transfer to Barcelona.

**DAY 1:** Departing from Barcelona, we will drive to a Mediterranean massif just inland from the coast to enjoy our first look at the rich and colourful birdlife of the Mediterranean.

DAY 2: Birding the Ebro Delta north and south of the river Ebro. Calm sea bays, spits, brackish lagoons, ricefields and saltpans.


DAY 3: We head inland to the beautiful Sierra de Guara. En-route we'll be visiting Ebro River meanders, wetlands, gallery woodland and dryland

DAY 4: Today we seek out some plains specialties in the drylands of Monegros, visiting impressive sandstone cliffs and semi-abandoned farmland along the way.

**DAY 5:** We follow the winding roads to high Pyrenees. En-route we admire gorges, stone bridges, sunny slopes and tiny hillside villages and their birds.

DAY 6: Today we'll be birding the high Pyrenees of Huesca: forests, pastures, mountain passes and river valleys, and some scenery you'll just love!

DAY 7: We depart for Barcelona, adjusting our itinerary perhaps to see a key bird or two we may have missed, or to visit a new area en-route. Tour ends in Barcelona.

# **SPRING ACROSS SPAIN**

#### **ITINERARY**

DAY 1: Arriving at Sevilla, we make our way to the Donana National Park and start exploring its wetlands, dehesa and woodlands.

DAY 2: We visit the wetlands and marshes of the Doñana National Park in search of a wide range of wetland birds, including some of the regional specialities.

DAY 3: We make our way to the southernmost tip of the Iberian Peninsula, near Tarifa, birding en-route at pools, saltpans, wetlands and farmland along the shores of the River Guadalquivir.

DAY 4: We search the area for rare species which have a mere toehold on the European continent here. Later we'll take a pelagic trip for seabirds, whales and dolphins.

DAY 5: We return to Sevilla to catch the fast train to Lleida, from where we will continue to the Ebro Delta, birding en-route.

DAY 6: We have a whole day birding the Ebro Delta - the lagoons, ricefields, bays, reedbeds and marshes of this great wetland area.

DAY 7: We head inland along the course of the River Ebro, stopping en-route to Lleida, to bird at gallery woodland, inland wetlands and drylands.

DAY 8: Our next destination is in the Pyrenees of Navarra. We will seek out some of the key birds we can see along the way, which may include Black Woodpecker and Rufous-tailed Rock Thrush.

**DAY 9:** Today we follow the Roncal Valley into France, birding all the way. The pastures, fields, forests and mountains offer a wide range of high mountain birds and magnificent landscapes.

#### WHAT'S SPECIAL ABOUT **THIS TOUR?**

•This is a variation of the **Great Spring Tour, covering** more ground, but with less driving •You'll be going from the southwest to the northeast of Spain-really across Spain

**DAY 10:** Today we do all we can to see a Wallcreeper, along with some of the species which usually occur in the same areas, such as Lammergeier, Citril Finch, and more.

**DAY 11:** Our search for elusive birds continues with a quest for the White-backed Woodpecker before heading south to a reed-fringed wetland, where we hope to see Bearded Reedling as well as a variety of ducks and arebes.

**DAY 12:** A pre-breakfast outing is best for locating the Dupont's Lark, along with sandgrouse and other dryland sandgrouse and other dryland species. Then we look for woodland birds, especially woodpeckers, concluding with a walk around some nearby wetlands.

DAY 13: Time for some last birding perhaps before catching the fast train from Zaragoza to Barcelona, where our tour ends.

### **Key birds:**

Mostly as for the Great Spring Tour but with likely additions of Marbled Duck, White-headed Duck, Crested (Red-knobbed) Coot, Northern Bald Ibis, Rüppell's Vulture, Little Swift, White-rumped Swift, Rufous Bush Robin, Isabelline Warbler, Black-headed Weaver.

### **ITINERARY**

**DAY 1:** Meeting at Barcelona we do our first birding around Lleida before making our way to our hotel in the Pyrenees, in the Chistau valley.

**DAY 2:** We'll be visiting sites in the upper reaches of the valleys looking for birds of forest, stream and mountains.

DAY 3: Today we'll drive up to a high mountain pass and over to the next valley to search a site for Wallcreeper. Then we'll retrace our steps back to our hotel.

DAY 4: We'll be birding all day en-route to Barcelona, adjusting our itinerary according to the birds and places we would like to see.

#### **ITINERARY**

DAY 1: From Bilbao we visit a coastal headland, the Urdaibai Biosphere reserve, and the Sierra de Urbasa, ending at Villafranca.

DAY 2: We'll be visiting the nearby drylands to look for some specialist bird species, as well as a bird-rich reed-fringed lagoon and gallery woodland.

**DAY 3:** We'll be searching for woodpeckers and other forest birds in some ancient woodland, and then taking a gentle walk around a nearby wetland area.

**DAY 4:** Exploring Mediterranean hillsides as we go, our main destination today will be to observe the Wallcreeper in its mountain haunts. From there we drive to the Roncal Valley.

DAY 5: The day is spent exploring the pastures, woodland and mountains of the Roncal Valley and the bordering area in France.


**DAY6:** We visit another ancient forest, where we hope to see the rare White-backed Woodpecker. From here we visit a gorge before returning to Bilbao, where the tour ends.

#### **ITINERARY**

**DAY 1:** Meeting at Santander or Bilbao we drive to the Picos de Europa National Park, with some birding en-route.

DAY 2: We take the cable car from Fuente Dé to a mountain habitat of over 1,800 m, providing us with excellent opportunities for seeing some of the special high-altitude birds.

DAY 3: We visit the San Glorio mountain pass, stopping en-route to look at birds and butterflies. In the afternoon we search several sites for Wildcats.

DAY 4: Today we visit another mountain pass to search the forests, slopes and meadows for birds and butterflies.

DAY 5: We leave this day's destination "open" to look at a site or area we have visited, or to explore local paths and tracks and see where they take us.

DAY 6: Return to Santander or Bilbao with visits to coastal wetlands if time permits.

# AMAZING MAMMALS

#### ITINERARY

**DAY 1:** Meeting at Asturias airport, Santander or Bilbao and transfer to our hotel near the Picos de Europa National Park.

DAY 2: We take the Fuente Dé cable car to the high mountain zone to look for alpine birds, and later we explore the local valley areas for more wildlife.

**DAY 3:** We visit the mountain pass of San Glorio, stopping en-route for birds and butterflies. We look for Wildcats too, and in the afternoon we have a programmed wolf-watching session.

DAY 4: We have programmed excursions for observing the Iberian Wolf in the morning and afternoon. In between we explore the valleys and hillsides.

DAY5: Today we head west to the Somiedo Natural Park, birding en-route. In the evening we have a programmed bear-watching excursion.

DAY 6: We dedicate most of the day to watching the Brown Bear, with sessions in the morning and evening. In-between we explore local meadows, woodlands and hillsides.

DAY 7: After one more session of bear-watching we take leave to return to our point of departure. The optional pelagic cruise extension departs from Bilbao the next day.



DAYS 1 TO 5: The tour starts at Málaga/Sevilla with the transfer to our accommodation near Tarifa.







\*At Birding In Spain we carefully consider the options available to us to optimize our choice of hotels. We think about proximity to the interesting birding areas, to minimize travel times, but also comfort and hygiene, food, service, character and location. We avoid city hotels and chains whenever possible (except Lleida), because many of us like to get up and bird before breakfast, and we appreciate the service that comes with a smile, especially when our hosts know we are there, understand what we are doing, and are grateful that we chose their establishment. Please bear in mind that we have been designing, organizing and leading birding tours since 1996.

#### **ABOUT FOOD AND MEALS**

On most of our tours of 3 days or more we include all meals in the tour price. These meals are usually

\*Breakfast-a buffet-style breakfast taken at the hotel, exceptionally in a good café,

\*A light picnic-style lunch or sandwich and drink taken in a local café or bar

\*\*\*A 3-course evening meal with starter, main course and dessert, accompanied with wine and water.

Please note: we do not eat at McDonald's or any other similar fast food chain.

## Meal times are as follows:

Breakfast is usually available from 7.30 or 8.00 am. At times we will organize a pre-breakfast excursion to return to have breakfast at a later time.

Lunch is usually taken after 1pm.

Evening meals are rarely, if ever, possible to organize before 8pm or 8.30pm. This is a national custom which we can do very little about!

Food standards are high. Fresh, crusty bread is used in the sandwiches, fresh fruit and often freshly-squeezed orange juice are available for breakfast. Coffee in Spain is excellent, although tea is less accomplished. Spain has many wine-growing regions of note which produce excellent red wines, some of which we may be served with our meals at the hotels. The most popular beers are light lagers. Tap water is good and safe to drink in most areas, we will advise when it is best avoided. The Ebro Delta is the natural home for seafood, while the mountain hotels have received frequent praise from our clients for the quality and variety of the food they serve.

#### RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

· You should bring your own binoculars, although we do have spare pairs which can be used if previously requested. Photographic equipment is fine if you have it, and a telescope and tripod too, although of course your guide will have his own which you will be invited to use whenever necessary.

• Comfortable boots for walking will be a positive asset, although we will not be expecting to walk for long distances over difficult terrain.

• Drinking water will be provided for daytime use but not for consumption in the hotels. It is recommended that you bring or acquire a water bottle for personal use and refilling.

• Sun cream is always a good idea.

• Insect repellant is probably not necessary but you may like to bring some if you have a particular need or aversion.

• Windbreaker light shower proof jackets are recommended as a minimum.

• As the weather is quite unpredictable these days you may well spend the whole time in shorts, or long sleeves, we really don't know! Please bring headgear for sun and for chilly conditions just in case, and warmer wear (sweaters, long trousers) for the mountain evenings is usually a good idea.

• For most tours we will provide you with a Birding In Spain notebook and tour checklist on arrival.

#### A NOTE ABOUT CURRENCIES AND EXCHANGE RATES

All of our prices are in euros because all of our expenses are in euros. In order to get an idea of what the listed euro prices are in your currecy (e.g. US Dollar, GBPound, etc) there are any number of currency converters available on Google. Just type in "Currency converter" and choose the one which catches your eye the most.

We could put the prices in other currencies too, and we would like to to make it easier for you to understand everything, but there are more problems than solutions provided with this approach:

(i) Exchange rates fluctuate and so may well do so between publication of the tour price and the final payment date for the tour, and if that happens then either you or us would be losing out (ii) to try and avoid the latter eventuality most tour companies would "up" the rate in foreign currencies to cushion themselves against unfavourable exchange rate trends, or would introduce a clause whereby prices may have to be increased due to external factors, either way this means that you could be asked to pay more, never less!

So we think the fairest system is to keep the prices in euros and to help you understand how much that is in your currecy should you need any help.
